On Thursday, April 30, the secure site for the Virginia Prescription Monitoring Program (http://www.pmp.dhp.virginia.gov) (PMP) was replaced with a \$US10M ransom demand:

"I have your shit! In *my* possession, right now, are **8,257,378** patient records and a total of **35,548,087** prescriptions. Also, I made an encrypted backup and deleted the original. Unfortunately for Virginia, their
